MISSION

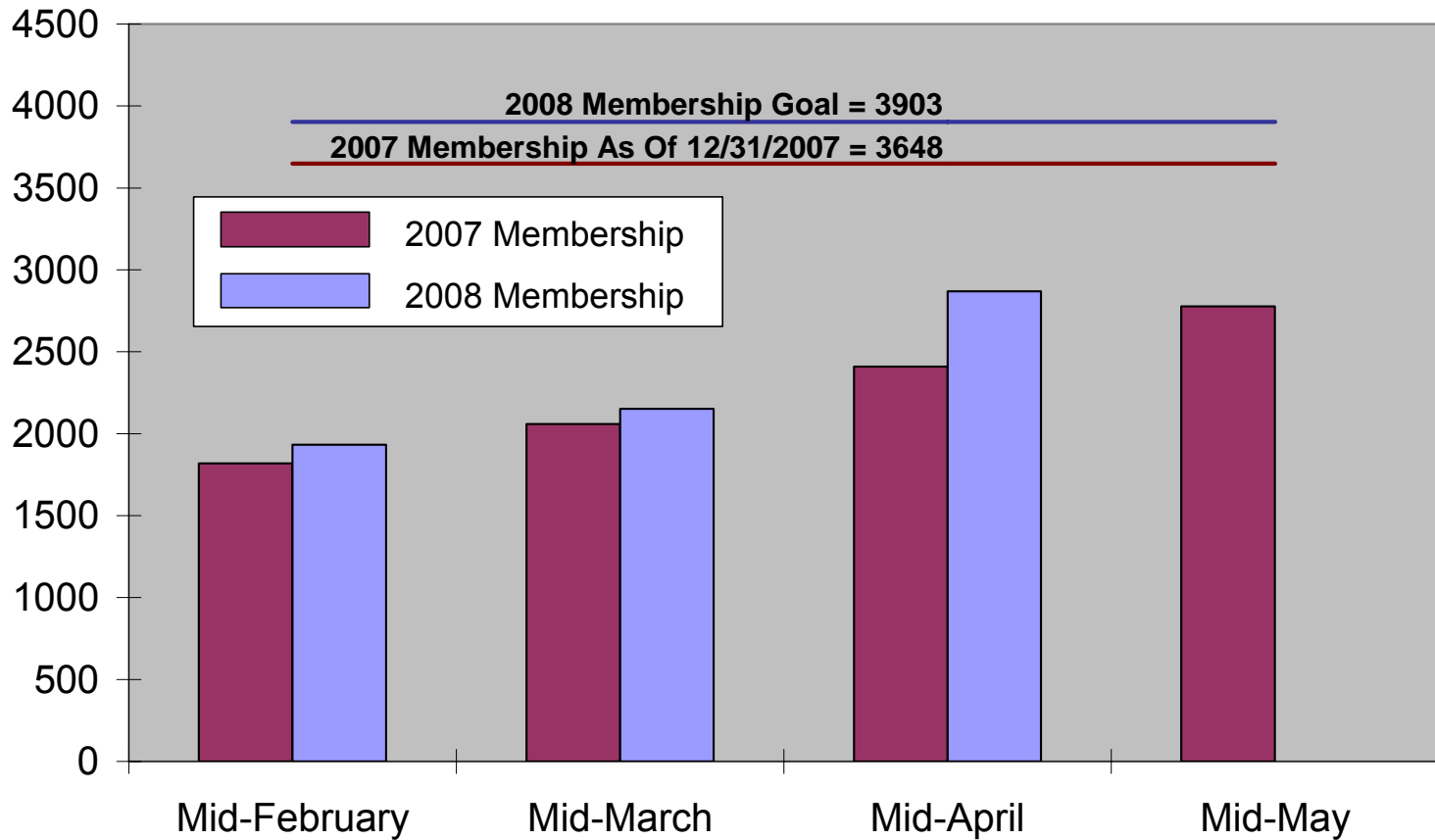
